Facebook for iPhone

1. Select the three-line menu in the bottom right-hand corner of the app.
2. Scroll to the bottom of the menu and select "Settings."
3. Select "News Feed Preferences."
4. Select "Prioritize who to see first."
5. Select the pages and profiles you want to see appear first in your news feed (including the [Shawano Schools](#), please and thank you!). The pages and profiles you select will show a blue badge with a star.
6. Select "Done."

Facebook for Android

1. Select the three-line menu in the top right-hand corner of the app.
